We are continuing our backpack program here at Hutchinson, We would love some help getting all the food our families could benefit from on the weekends.

This year community members have come together and we have some supplies of canned and non perishable items we will keep at Hutchinson for the backpacks. We will use [Foothills Foodies](#) to supplement cold food,

fresh produce, as well as any items we don't have at Hutchinson.

This volunteer job needs people who can do these steps:

1. Pick up backpacks/boxes from Hutchinson - Room 20 outside door
 - a. The door will have a sign noting it is the Husky Pack Program location
 - b. A staff member will meet you and provide you with the details on what food is needed
2. Head over to Foothills Elementary
3. Check in at the front office
4. Sign in as Hutchinson
5. Shop based on needs of the family
6. Bring backpacks/boxes back to Hutchinson and drop them at Room 20

Welcome to the Husky Pack Program



To ensure the process goes smoothly, we are providing you with a few important details about the program and how it will operate. Every Friday that school is in session, your child's distribution will be sent home with them. If a snow day occurs on a Friday, we will make every effort to send bags home the next day that school is in session but we cannot guarantee this will happen. If your child is absent on a Friday, their bag will be sent home the following Friday.

This is a "BackPack Program", you will be receiving backpacks. We will be sending backpacks home with in-person students and delivering boxes to remote students. For in-person students please send the empty backpack back with your child on the following school day (Monday or Tuesday if there is a holiday). If your student is remote please hold on to the box and we will pick it up when we deliver the food the following week.

Please note your child will often bring home bags that are quite full. We will be making every effort to provide as much food as possible while keeping in mind that your child must be able to carry their bag. We acquire food from multiple sources and occasionally the availability of items is low. As a result, you may notice that some weeks have fewer items than others. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience this may cause.. All BackPack participants are required to keep his/her distribution bags and its contents closed until they get home
